Clarity of purpose and focus helped the Asphalt Institute Foundation (AIF) overcome the COVID-19 pandemic impacts to our programs last year. While our June Internship Program, annual Golf Scramble Fundraiser and the reserved tables program at the AI Annual Meeting all fell by the wayside, we're planning the December 2021 events with hopes they can be conducted safely.

These cancellations gave us the opportunity to increase efforts in other areas as demonstrated in the launch of a new AI Foundation website in October and our first donor newsletter in November. These are examples of how the foundation is taking our donors seriously and improving communications while deliberately providing new means to fulfill the foundation's mission.

As you'll see in this report, the first awards from the Bill and Shireen Kirk Scholarship Fund were presented last year. Additionally, the launch of the Asphalt Technology Module gives colleges and universities across the United States and Canada the opportunity to enable students to learn more about asphalt as the premium construction material.

We've rescheduled the Strategic Asphalt Research (STAR) Symposium for May of 2022, enabling us to preserve the necessary in-person collaboration essential to its success. Sponsorship for the STAR has exceeded expectations, signaling the importance of this type of discussion in our industry.

The leadership and commitment of our volunteers is further showcased throughout this report, yet let us highlight the effort given over the past three years by past AI Foundation Chair Austin Miller. We developed many of our signature programs under his tenure and importantly, Austin remains a key advocate for the foundation. We can't thank him enough for his leadership.

Last year we expanded the size of the AIF Board and several of our committees providing more opportunities to serve. We welcome your input and engagement.

Advancing Education

In October 2020, AIF launched a new Asphalt Technology Module (ATM) designed to provide engineering students with an introduction to asphalt and flexible paving technology. The



short course consists of six 50-minute sessions that is an ideal addition to a basic engineering and/or construction materials course for undergraduate engineering or engineering technology students. The module is available upon

request to university professors and instructors and includes complimentary eBooks to supplement the curriculum.

To date, 68 professors from 59 colleges and universities have requested access to the module for utilization in their classrooms. The AI Foundation has received positive feedback from these professors on the quality of materials and curriculum contained in the module.

The module is the first project made possible by a \$40,000 grant from Jebro Inc. and the MDU Resources Foundation.

The grant will also fund future projects and course modules targeting both graduate and undergraduate level students. Work on Phase II of the project will begin later this year. Laboratory instruction modules that will complement the undergraduate lectures will be developed during this stage.

UNIVERSITY TEXTBOOK PROGRAM

Since 2017, more than 3,100 eBook and hardcopy publications have been provided to undergraduate and graduate level engineering students across the United States through AIF's University Textbook Program. The goal of the textbook program is to assist university professors and students with asphalt industry resource manuals and reference material that will enhance their classroom studies of asphalt pavement engineering.

ASPHALT INSTITUTE FOUNDATION INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

Due to COVID-19 concerns, the annual Asphalt Institute Foundation Internship Program was not held in 2020. The objective of the internship program is to attract new professionals to the asphalt industry by providing real-world experiences, along with professional networking opportunities. Held at the Asphalt Institute Headquarters, member company interns take part in “Asphalt 101” via presentations and demonstrations that include tours of the binder and mix

design laboratories. Attendees also learn about the organizational significance of the Asphalt Institute and the Asphalt Institute Foundation. A key program highlight is an asphalt industry career panel discussion and Q&A session. Panelists share their unique story, personal and professional experiences and educational path that led to their current position within the asphalt industry.

A signature program for AIF, we look forward to hosting this program in future years once travel restrictions and COVID-19 concerns are alleviated.



BILL AND SHIREEN KIRK SCHOLARSHIP FUND



The AI Foundation announced the first scholarship recipients of the Bill and Shireen Kirk Scholarship Fund in early June. The fund is made possible by the Kirks who endowed \$500,000 to the program.

The fund will annually award scholarships to third or fourth

year undergraduate, masters or doctoral students studying business, chemistry, civil engineering, construction management, marketing or sales. Scholarship funds totaling \$25,000 were awarded to five Kirk Scholars for the 2020-2021 school year. Recipients include:

Kyrsten Grace Dallanegra, Virginia Tech



Dallanegra is a civil engineering major at Virginia Tech. She is from Annapolis, Maryland and is active in the Naval ROTC program. Her plans include being a submariner or working in the Navy Civil Engineering Corps.

Ricky Lamar Hall II, Auburn University



Hall is a civil engineering major at Auburn University. He is from Dothan, Alabama and works as an engineering tutor. His plans include working as a structural engineer in multiple states.

Tanner Caleb Keen, Virginia Tech



Keen is a civil engineering major at Virginia Tech. He is from Riner, Virginia and works for the Virginia Department of Transportation as a construction manager. He plans to work in highway and bridge construction.

Richard Lee, University of Texas at Austin



Lee is a civil engineering major at The University of Texas at Austin. He is from Plano, Texas and works as an asphalt laboratory research assistant. He plans to focus on safety in transportation engineering.

Jessica Victoria Lewis, Mississippi State University



Lewis is a civil engineering major at Mississippi State University. She is from New Orleans, Louisiana and is an undergraduate research assistant where she is testing bio-based asphalt rejuvenators. She plans to obtain her Ph.D. and teach at the university level.

Recipients of the 2021 Bill and Shireen Kirk Scholarship Fund will be announced later this summer. The 2022 scholarship program application will be available via the AIF website in late October.



Advancing Research



Since the 2017 Strategic Asphalt Research (STAR) Symposium, the Asphalt Institute Foundation's Research Committee has worked diligently to develop research needs statements and request for proposals in areas that were identified during this unique industry event.

After a thorough review process, the AIF Research Committee recommended that an asphalt sustainability research contract be awarded to the University of Washington. Additionally, a research grant in the area of asphalt durability was awarded to Nynas AB. Both groups will report on their research findings during the 2022 Strategic Asphalt Research (STAR) Symposium in Atlanta, GA.



These projects are in addition to The Heritage Group's \$600,000 contribution in late 2019 to establish the Fred M. Fehsenfeld, Sr. Catalyst for Change Initiative. This program will separately fund research and education initiatives that promote innovation and advancement in public procurement; transportation system design; asphalt pavement testing methodology; health, safety and environmental stewardship; and more.

Looking ahead, the AIF Research Committee will launch a request for proposal process in the area of roofing asphalt sustainability.

The committee will also continue to work with AIF's Development Committee to secure research funding for future strategic projects.





2022 STAR SYMPOSIUM INNOVATING ASPHALT – THE ROAD AHEAD

The Asphalt Institute Foundation is making plans for the second Strategic Asphalt Research Symposium (STAR) now being held, May 16-18, 2022, at the W Atlanta-Midtown in Atlanta, GA.

On the recommendation of the STAR Symposium Task Force, the AI Foundation Board of Directors made the decision to move the event from 2021 to 2022 due to travel restrictions and COVID-19 concerns.



The three-day event will focus on identifying strategic research areas and topics that will lead to breakthrough change for the future of the asphalt industry. The foundation looks forward to hosting individuals from around the world in Atlanta, GA, to discuss the asphalt technology of tomorrow.


